## **PROJECT INVITATION**



Dear Parents,

Second through fifth grade students are invited to submit science projects for the upcoming Science Fair on March  $6^{th}$ , 2020 from 6 - 8 pm. Awards will be presented. Students may complete their science fair project independently or with a partner. Science fair packet will be emailed to all participants that provides an email address.

## Guidelines:

- 1. Projects should be problem based. This means that their project must solve a problem (a hypothesis).
- 2. The final project must be on a tri-fold board (approximately 1 meter tall). The project must include all steps of the scientific method.
- 3. If students are partnering, parents must plan for them to work together outside of school. All work should be equally shared.
- 4. Projects must be the work of the student/students. Parental help is allowed and encouraged but ultimately the students must be able to present how they performed the experiment.
- 5. Student's name and teacher's name must be written on back of the display board.
- 6. Projects will set up in the gym after school the afternoon of March 6<sup>th</sup> and be ready for judging at 6 pm. Students need to be present for judging. Projects may be dropped off the morning of the science fair.
